Unity of Palm Harbor held its first service in its newly completed sanctuary in 2007. The Rev. Bob Fortner, who has served the congregation as Sr. Minister since 1995, is joined by Asst. Minister Rev. Marilyn Earhart. Active with worship services, classes, seminars and special events, spiritual education for youth and teens, and spiritual counseling through its prayer team (which includes licensed Unity teachers, ministers, and prayer chaplains), Unity Church of Palm Harbor also supports Religious Community Services (an organization dedicated to service in the community), Habitat for Humanity, and Para Los Niños, a non-profit organization which builds schools and delivers supplies to schools in Honduras. UCPH is a member of the Association of Unity Churches International and is affiliated with Unity School of Christianity, publishers of *Daily Word*.

The congregation's home is on a 4-acre property that is lush with granddaddy oaks, tropical growth, and landscaping of flowering plants through which mulched paths, swings, and picnic tables wend their way. The newly-opened sanctuary building was designed and erected with extreme care to necessitate the minimal removal of trees and natural growth. These extraordinary grounds, cared for by Maureen Fortner and members of the Garden Ministry team, are enjoyed by the congregation and members of the community-at-large, who are invited to immerse themselves in the serene beauty with a walk, a picnic, or meditation among the oaks.
